## INGREDIENTS

Corn, Wheat Middlings, Distillers Dried Grains with Solubles, Soybean Meal, Cane Molasses, Calcium Carbonate, Soybean Oil, Salt, Dicalcium Phosphate, Lignin Sulfonate, Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin D-3 Supplement, Vitamin E Supplement, Vitamin B-12 Supplement, Menadione Sodium Bisulfite Complex, Riboflavin Supplement, d-Calcium Pantothenate, Niacin Supplement, Choline Chloride, Zinc Sulfate, Ferrous Sulfate, Manganous Sulfate, Copper Sulfate, Ethylenediamine Dihydrochloride, Cobalt Sulfate, and Sodium Selenite.

## FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Calves can be early weaned at 4 weeks of age if they are consuming 2 lbs per head, per day.

At 5 days of age, feed 15% Cattle Pellet in addition to a good milk replacer.

At 3 weeks of age, begin to offer small amounts of good quality hay.

At 4 weeks and older, offer full feed of 15% Cattle Pellet with any hay free choice.

**Feed with good quality hay and always provide access to clean, fresh water.**  
**Store feed in a cool, dry place.**

*Feed more frequently in smaller amounts to keep feed fresh. A build up of feed can cause mold.*
